## From the Pastor

My Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for your prayer, fasting, and almsgiving during this Lenten Season! You are an inspiration to myself and to others!

**Holy Week:** We now enter into Holy Week 2018. Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord is when Our Lord entered into Jerusalem amid cries of "Hosanna!" Holy Thursday is when Our Lord gave us the Sacrament of the Eucharist and instituted the Holy Priesthood. Good Friday is the day of the Lord's passion, crucifixion, and death on the cross. Then we wait and watch in vigil on Holy Saturday for that glorious celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord on Easter Sunday. These are holy days for Catholics and all other Christians. I encourage you and your families to allow for more prayer, more reading of the Scriptures, and for more reflection with one another on these events.

**Chrism Mass:** On Tuesday March 27, Bishop Burns will celebrate the Mass of Chrism with his clergy, in particular the priests who are serving in the Diocese of Dallas. This is a sign of unity and communion of the priests with their bishop. During this Mass of Chrism, Bishop Burns will bless the Oil of Sacred Chrism, the Oil of the Catechumens, and the Oil of the Sick or Infirm for use in each diocesan parish. Please pray for our bishops and our priests!
