From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*) is a very special day for us in the Catholic Church. Christ loved us so much that He gave Himself as the sacrifice, the Lamb of God, to take away our sins and give us new life, new hope, new meaning. But even more, He gave Himself to us as real food, His Body and Blood, so that we remain connected to Him, strengthened and nourished during our pilgrimage on earth toward our home in heaven. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: (1416) Communion with the Body and Blood of Christ increases the communicant's union with the Lord, forgives his venial sins, and preserves him from grave sins. Since receiving this sacrament strengthens the bonds of charity between the communicant and Christ, it also reinforces the unity of the Church as the Mystical Body of Christ." In short, we need Jesus, especially in the Eucharist! It is not just "what" we receive but "Who" we receive in Holy Communion. We must be careful not to take this sacrament for granted. Preparation is necessary. As Roman Catholics who believe that we truly receive Our Lord Jesus Christ in Holy Communion, let us encourage one another to worthily receive Our Lord by preparing as Holy Mother Church instructs us through the Catechism: "Anyone who desires to receive Christ in Eucharistic communion must be in the state of grace. Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance (1415).

Preparation for Reception of Holy Communion: The Church gives us as properly catechized and initiated Roman Catholic specific guidelines for preparing ourselves to receive Holy Communion worthily: (1) to be in the state of grace (to have made a good confession since your last mortal sin), (2) to observe the Eucharistic fast, that is, not to have eaten any food one hour prior to receiving Holy Communion (which means no gum chewing either!), and (3) not to be under any ecclesiastical censure such as not married with permission of the Roman Catholic Church or placing oneself outside the practice of the faith. It is truly the Lord Jesus Christ Whom we are receiving! Let us prepare well for each opportunity we have to receive Him!

Mis queridos feligreses,

La solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo (*Corpus Christi*) es un día muy especial para nosotros en la Iglesia Católica. Cristo nos amó tanto que se entregó a sí mismo como sacrificio, el Cordero de Dios, para quitar nuestros pecados y darnos nueva vida, nueva esperanza, nuevo significado. Pero aún más, Él se entregó a nosotros como alimento real, Su Cuerpo y Sangre, para que permanezcamos conectados a Él, fortalecidos y alimentados durante nuestra peregrinación en la tierra hacia nuestro hogar en el cielo. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica dice: (1416) La comunión con el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo aumenta la unión del comulgante con el Señor, perdona sus pecados veniales y lo preserva de los pecados graves. Desde que recibir este sacramento fortalece los lazos de caridad entre el comulgante y Cristo, también refuerza la unidad de la Iglesia como el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo ". En resumen, ¡necesitamos a Jesús, especialmente en la Eucaristía! No solo es lo "qué" recibimos, sino también a "Quién" recibimos en la Santa Comunión. Debemos tener cuidado de no dar por sentado este sacramento. La preparación es necesaria. Como católicos romanos que creemos que realmente recibimos a Nuestro Señor Jesucristo en la Sagrada Comunión, animémonos unos a otros a recibir dignamente a Nuestro Señor preparándonos como la Santa Madre Iglesia nos instruye a través del Catecismo: "Todo aquel que desee recibir a Cristo en la comunión eucarística debe estar en el estado de gracia. Cualquier persona consciente de haber pecado mortalmente no debe recibir la comunión sin haber recibido la absolución en el sacramento de la penitencia (1415).

Preparación para la recepción de la Sagrada Comunión: La Iglesia nos brinda, como catequizados e iniciados, los lineamientos católicos romanos específicos para prepararnos para recibir la Sagrada Comunión digna: (1) estar en estado de gracia (haber hecho una buena confesión desde su último pecado mortal), (2) observar el ayuno eucarístico, es decir, no haber comido nada una hora antes de recibir la Santa Comunión (¡lo que significa que tampoco se masca chicle!), y (3) no estar bajo ninguna censura eclesiástica como como no casado con permiso de la Iglesia Católica Romana o colocándose fuera de la práctica de la fe. ¡Es verdaderamente el Señor Jesucristo a quien estamos recibiendo! ¡Preparémonos bien para cada oportunidad que tengamos para recibirlo!
