From the Parochial Vicar

Dear Parishioners,

Several years ago, a friend of mine began discerning a vocation to the priesthood. When his parents learned about this discernment, they were horrified! In their minds, their son was entertaining the idea of throwing his life away. When my friend pressed ahead and entered the seminary, his father was so furious that he did not speak to him for several years.

Stories like these (and there are many others) serve as reminders that we Catholics often are the reason why “the harvest is abundant *but the laborers are few.*” Many Catholic parents will say that they want more priests...so long as they do not come from their own families.

People give various reasons for discouraging their sons, grandsons, brothers, and friends from the priesthood: the shame of the clergy abuse scandal, the longing for grandchildren, the desire for these men to do something more “productive” with their lives, and so on. On a human level these fears are understandable. However, when seen with the eyes of faith, they reveal a form of spiritual self-centeredness, a weak sense of sacrifice, and a lack of trust in God’s goodness.

The vocation to the priesthood is a gift from God, and Jesus’ sending of the 72 disciples in today’s Gospel reminds us why this vocation is a gift: called by Christ, these men are sent out to prepare others to encounter the Lord. They are called to walk with God’s people on the pilgrimage to true and lasting freedom in Jesus Christ. When these disciples return to Jesus, we see revealed the joy and purpose of their vocation: *“The seventy-two returned rejoicing, and said, ‘Lord, even the demons are subject to us because of your name.”* Without the work of these disciples, whole towns and villages would remain slaves to sin and unable to welcome Jesus.

Jesus calls these chosen men to be bridges that join people to God. In this work, they prefigure priests and their ordained ministry in the life of the Church. As Pope Benedict XVI wrote, “No man on his own, relying on his own power, can put another in touch with God. An essential part of the priest’s grace is the gift, the task of creating this contact...As an act of God’s infinite mercy, he calls some ‘to be’ with Him and to become, through the sacrament of Orders, despite their human poverty, sharers in His own priesthood, ministers of sanctification, stewards of His mysteries, ‘bridges’ to the encounter with Him and of His mediation between God and man and between man and God.” As a Christian, that does not sound like a wasted life!

As we pray for God to send more laborers for His harvest—more bridges for His people—more priests for His Church—let’s ask for the courage to promote priestly vocations within our own parish and our own families. *“The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.”*

Del vicario parroquial

Mis queridos feligreses,

Hace varios años, un amigo mío comenzó a discernir su vocación al sacerdocio. Cuando sus padres se enteraron de este discernimiento ¡se horrorizaron! Realmente sintieron que su hijo estaba contemplando la idea de desperdiciar su vida. Como mi amigo siguió adelante y entró al seminario, su padre estaba tan furioso que no le habló durante varios años.

Historias como esta (y hay muchas otras) sirven como recordatorio de que los católicos a menudo somos la razón por la cual “la cosecha es abundante pero los trabajadores son pocos”. Muchos padres católicos dicen que quieren más sacerdotes ... siempre y cuando no salgan de sus propias familias.

La gente da muchas razones para desalentar a sus hijos, nietos, hermanos y amigos de ser sacerdotes: la vergüenza del escándalo por los abusos del clero, el sueño de los nietos, el deseo de que estos hombres hagan algo más “productivo” con sus vidas ... etcétera. Mientras que a nivel humano estos temores son comprensibles, cuando se ven con los ojos de la fe, revelan una forma de egocentrismo espiritual, un débil sentido de sacrificio y una falta de confianza en la bondad de Dios.

La vocación al sacerdocio es un don de Dios y el envío de los 72 discípulos por parte de Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy nos recuerda por qué esta vocación es un don: llamados por Cristo, estos hombres son enviados para salir y preparar a otros para encontrar al Señor. Están llamados a caminar con el pueblo de Dios en la peregrinación a la verdadera y duradera libertad en Jesucristo. Cuando estos discípulos regresan a Jesús, vemos que se revela el gozo y el propósito de su vocación: “Los setenta y dos se regocijaron y dijeron: “Señor, incluso los demonios están sujetos a nosotros por tu nombre”. Sin el trabajo de los discípulos, pueblos y aldeas enteras seguirían siendo esclavos del pecado e incapaces de recibir a Jesús.

Jesús llama a estos hombres elegidos a ser puentes que unan a las personas con Dios. En este trabajo, prefiguran a los sacerdotes y su ministerio ordenado en la vida de la Iglesia. Como escribió el papa Benedicto XVI, “Ningún hombre solo, confiando en su propio poder, puede poner a otro en contacto con Dios. Una parte esencial de la gracia del sacerdote es el don, la tarea de crear este contacto ... Como un acto de la misericordia infinita de Dios, llama a algunos a “estar” con Él y convertirse, a través del sacramento del Orden, a pesar de su pobreza humana, partícipes de su propio sacerdocio, ministros de santificación, administradores de sus misterios, “puentes” para el encuentro con Él y de su mediación entre Dios y el hombre y entre el hombre y Dios”. ¡Eso no suena como una vida desperdiciada!

Mientras oramos para que Dios envíe más obreros para su cosecha, más puentes para su pueblo, más sacerdotes para su iglesia, pidamos el valor para promover las vocaciones sacerdotales dentro de nuestra propia parroquia y nuestras propias familias. “La cosecha es abundante pero los obreros son pocos; así que pídale al maestro de la cosecha que envíe obreros para su cosecha”.
