Dear Parents of students preparing for First Holy Communion,

Below are the measures we are taking to continue our work of faith formation in partnership with you during this time.

On campus classes for children and parents are cancelled until further notice. However, the work of religious education never stops! Faith formation will continue at home.

The church always emphasizes that parents are the primary teachers of the faith. This challenging event is an opportunity for us to live out our catechetical responsibilities in a special way. To assist parents in this work, St. Monica Catholic Church will provide books, materials, and lesson plans for parents to use at home. When classes resume, quizzes and worksheets will be turned in to your child(ren)'s catechist.

We ask that each family come to pick up their child(ren)'s books, materials, and at-home lesson plans in the school cafeteria on or before 2:00pm, Sunday, March 22nd.
