Divine Mercy Sunday: This Second Sunday of Easter used to be called "Low Sunday" referring to the regular tone of celebration compared to the "high" celebration of Easter. Now, this Sunday is called Divine Mercy Sunday. The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

A - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

B - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

Spend time to learn more about the mercy of God, learn to trust in Jesus, and live your life as merciful to others, as Christ is merciful to you.

Easter Duty Obligation: In keeping with the precepts of the Catholic Church, Holy Communion should be received worthily (after Confession, if necessary) anytime beginning on Easter Sunday, April 4, through Trinity Sunday, May 30. (See *Catechism of the Catholic Church* 2042).

Domingo de la Divina Misericordia: Este segundo domingo de Pascua solía llamarse "Domingo bajo" en referencia al tono regular de la celebración en comparación con la celebración "alta" de la Pascua. Ahora bien, este domingo se llama Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. El mensaje de la Divina Misericordia es uno que podemos recordar simplemente recordando ABC:

A - Pide Su Misericordia. Dios quiere que nos acerquemos a Él en oración constantemente, arrepintiéndonos de nuestros pecados y pidiéndole que derrame Su misericordia sobre nosotros y sobre el mundo entero.

B - Sea misericordioso. Dios quiere que recibamos Su misericordia y la dejemos fluir a través de nosotros hacia los demás. Él quiere que extendamos amor y perdón a los demás tal como lo hace con nosotros.

C - Confiar plenamente en Jesús. Dios quiere que sepamos que las gracias de su misericordia dependen de nuestra confianza. Cuanto más confiemos en Jesús, más recibiremos.

Dedique tiempo a aprender más sobre la misericordia de Dios, aprenda a confiar en Jesús y viva su vida como misericordioso con los demás, como Cristo es misericordioso con usted.

Obligación de Pascua: De acuerdo con los preceptos de la Iglesia Católica, la Sagrada Comunión debe recibirse dignamente (después de la Confesión, si es necesario) en cualquier momento a partir del Domingo de Pascua, 4 de abril, hasta el Domingo de Trinidad, 30 de mayo (*ver Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica 2042*).
