# From the Pastor

My Dear Parishioners,

**Good Neighbors:** In today's Gospel reading a scholar of the law asks Jesus what must be done to inherit eternal life. After Jesus reminds him of law that shows the necessity of loving God and neighbor, the scholar asks, "And who is my neighbor?" Our Lord then shows him a different view of neighbor. In looking at "neighbor," this parable brings up another question: what is more important, duty or hospitality? This is a tough question for all of us who are driven by legality or what we perceive as success. Hospitality and evangelization go hand in hand. Welcoming strangers, giving food to the hungry, taking time to be with someone who needs to know that they are loved is part of how we can evangelize and help draw others closer to Christ. It is interesting to see that Our Lord did not define the neighbor as the victim but as the one who took care of the victim. But this was a Samaritan, one who was despised because of cultural differences. In the end, the scholar has to say that the one who possesses the most holy characteristics is the one he least expected: The Samaritan. And those characteristics are shown by the "one who treated him with mercy." It is not what is on the outside that matters as much as what is on the inside that we are willing to share. Wherever we go, to work, to school, on vacation, we are called to remember that we have an opportunity to show mercy, to evangelize through hospitality, to love one another. Even though there are risks involved in caring for others, the results of discovering the Good News are worth the effort for all involved. How can I be a good neighbor at home, on vacation, at work?

**Preparation for Reception of Holy Communion:** The Church gives us as properly catechized and initiated Roman Catholic specific guidelines for preparing ourselves to receive Holy Communion worthily: (1) to be in the state of grace (to have made a good confession since your last mortal sin), (2) to observe the Eucharistic fast, that is, not to have eaten any food one hour prior to receiving Holy Communion (which means no gum chewing either!), and (3) not to be under any ecclesiastical censure such as not married with permission of the Roman Catholic Church or placing oneself outside the practice of the faith. It is truly the Lord Jesus Christ Whom we are receiving! Let us prepare well for each opportunity we have to receive Him!

# Del Pastor

Mis queridos feligreses,

**Buenos vecinos:** en el Evangelio de hoy, un alumno de la ley le pregunta a Jesús qué debe hacer para heredar la vida eterna. Después de que Jesús le recuerda la ley que muestra la necesidad de amar a Dios y al prójimo, el alumno pregunta: “¿Y quién es mi prójimo?” Nuestro Señor le muestra una visión diferente del prójimo. Al mirar al “vecino”, esta parábola plantea otra pregunta: ¿qué es más importante, deber u hospitalidad? Esta es una pregunta difícil para todos nosotros que somos impulsados por la legalidad o lo que percibimos como éxito. Hospitalidad y evangelización van de la mano. Dar la bienvenida a extraños, dar comida a los hambrientos, dedicar tiempo a estar con alguien que necesita saber que son amados es parte de cómo podemos evangelizar y ayudar a otros a acercarse a Cristo. Es interesante ver que Nuestro Señor no definió al prójimo como la víctima, sino como el que cuidó a la víctima. Pero este era un samaritano, uno que fue despreciado por las diferencias culturales. Al final, el alumno tiene que decir que el que posee las características más sagradas es el que menos esperaba: el samaritano. Y esas características son mostradas por el “que lo trató con misericordia”. Lo que importa no es lo que está en el exterior lo que importa tanto como lo que está dentro, lo que estamos dispuestos a compartir. Dondequiera que vayamos, al trabajo, a la escuela, de vacaciones, estamos llamados a recordar que tenemos la oportunidad de mostrar misericordia, de evangelizar a través de la hospitalidad, de amarnos unos a otros. A pesar de que existen riesgos relacionados con el cuidado de los demás, los resultados de descubrir la Buena Nueva valen el esfuerzo de todos los involucrados. ¿Cómo puedo ser un buen vecino en casa, de vacaciones, en el trabajo?

**Preparación para la recepción de la Sagrada Comunión:** La Iglesia nos brinda, como catequizados e iniciados, los lineamientos específicos católicos romanos para prepararnos para recibir la Sagrada Comunión digna: (1) estar en estado de gracia (haber hecho una buena confesión desde su último pecado mortal), (2) observar el ayuno eucarístico, es decir, no haber comido nada una hora antes de recibir la Santa Comunión (¡lo que significa que tampoco se masca chicle!), y (3) no estar bajo ninguna censura eclesiástica como como no casado con permiso de la Iglesia Católica Romana o colocándose fuera de la práctica de la fe. ¡Es verdaderamente el Señor Jesucristo a quien estamos recibiendo! ¡Preparémonos bien para cada oportunidad que tengamos para recibirlo!
