From the Pastor



recent New Yorker cartoon showed a large door, locked with three heavy bolts. In addition to the bolts, a sturdy chain reinforced

the door, and just to make sure that nothing could invade the formidable fortress, a long bar was securely fastened across the width of the door to the door posts. And yet, upon closer examination, it was clear that someone had managed to slip a valentine under the door. In so many ways, this image is a metaphor for what Jesus does for us at Easter.

Countless things worry us. Often it is our relationship with God that causes us uneasiness because we can't seem to give up a sinful habit or do anything more than the minimum in our spiritual life. Sometimes the future worries us as we help a child in trouble or consider a major life change. On occasion we face ambiguous health news. fret about our job, or agonize over someone being present when they're needed. Over and over the concerns of life weigh us down or close in on us. It's not unlike lock after lock being snapped shut, closing out all happiness and tranquility.

When we read the gospel accounts about Jesus appearing to his apostles and others after the Resurrection, we learn that his most common greeting is "Peace be with you." It's not just another way to say "Hello." It is a promise. Jesus knew the challenges the apostles would face. They were going to experience uncertainty and endure suffering and persecution in the years ahead; but despite these struggles, they were going to remain confident. They knew they would not be alone. Jesus would be with them - Peace would be with them.

The same is true for us today. We don't have to be discouraged by our sins or because we can't easily scrap our bad habits. The Divine Mercy we celebrate today is offered to us over and over without limit. As we worry about the welfare of a loved one, we do not pray alone. Jesus is at our side joining in because he loves them and is concerned for their need more than we can imagine. In every struggle and in each dark moment of life we can go on with confidence as we remember that the solution is not really in our hands. Someone who loves us completely is in control of everything.

When human beings chose to disobey God his response was not to punish them but to send his Son to live amongst them. Jesus Christ chose to embrace the Cross and die a terrible death, and as he did, he offered himself up for us, thinking only of us and our sins. Then, when he returned to life, he promised to be with us until the end of time, and so he shall!

Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, and the lesson of today is that no matter what trouble or darkness may enter your life, you can discover peace. It is as if our Father in Heaven slipped a valentine under a door we slammed shut to keep out our troubles. Our Father sent his Son so that we would have no reason to doubt how much we are loved.



De El Pastor



n reciente dibujo animado del *New Yorker* mostró una puerta grande cerrada con tres tornillos. Además

de los tornillos, una cadena pesada reforzaba la puerta y solo para asegurar que nada invadiera la formidable fuerza, una barra larga estaba sujetada a lo ancho de la puerta sobre los postes. Y sin embargo, al examinar de cerca, era evidente que alguien había c onseguido pasar una carta de amor por debajo de la puerta. De muchas maneras, esta imagen es una metáfora de lo que Jesús hace por nosotros en Pascua.

Innumerables cosas nos preocupan. A menudo es nuestra relación con Dios la que nos inquieta porque no somos capaces de dejar un hábito pecaminoso o hacer algo más que lo mínimo sobre nuestra vida espiritual. Algunas veces nos preocupamos del futuro como cuando ayudamos a un niño que está necesitado o cuando consideramos un cambio grande en nuestra vida. En ocasiones enfrentamos noticias inciertas de salud, dudas sobre nuestro trabajo o nos atormentamos porque alquien esté o no presente cuando son necesitados. Más y más las preocupaciones de la vida nos pesan o nos encierran. Es como la cerradura que después de haber sido cerrada deja afuera toda la felicidad y tranquilidad.

Cuando leemos los relatos de Jesús en los Evangelios que se aparece a los apóstoles y a otros después de la Resurrección, aprendemos que su saludo más común es "La Paz este con ustedes." No es simplemente otra manera de decir "Hola." Es una promesa. Jesús sabía los retos que enfrentarían los apóstoles. Iban a experimentar inseguridades y soportar sufrimientos y persecuciones en los años venideros; pero aparte de estas luchas, se mantendrían confiados. Sabían que no estarían solos. Jesús estaría con ellos - la Paz estaría con ellos.

Es lo mismo para nosotros hoy día. No debemos desanimarnos por nuestros pecados o porque no tan fácil podemos quitarnos nuestros malos hábitos. La Divina Misericordia que celebramos hoy cada vez nos da sin límites. Cuando nos preocupamos por el bienestar de un ser querido, no oramos solos. Jesús se une a nosotros porque los ama y se preocupa por sus necesidades más de lo que nos podemos imaginar. En cada lucha y en cada momento oscuro de la vida podemos estar confiados recordando que la solución no está en nuestras manos. Alguien que completamente nos ama tiene el control de todo.

Cuando los humanos decidieron desobedecer a Dios, su respuesta no fue castigarlos sino mandar a su Hijo a vivir entre ellos. Jesucristo decidió tomar la Cruz y tener una muerte terrible, y tal como lo hizo, ofreció su vida por nosotros pensando solamente en nosotros y nuestros pecados. Entonces cuando volvió a la vida, prometió estar con nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos, y así lo hará!

Hoy celebramos el Domingo dela Divina Misericordia y la enseñanza es que no importa la preocupación u oscuridad que entre en su vida, aun puede descubrir la paz. Es como si nuestro Padre del Cielo deslizará una carta de amor debajo nuestra puerta, que está cerrada para dejar afuera nuestras preocupaciones. Nuestro Padre envió a su Hijo para que no tuviéramos ninguna razón para dudar cuanto nos ama.
