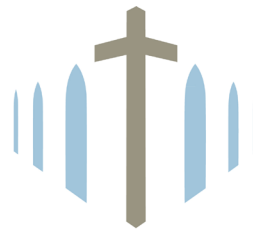

# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

**Holy Communion Guidelines**

**For Catholics** - As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Holy Mass when we receive Holy Communion. We are encouraged to receive our Eucharistic Lord devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Him, the communicant should not be conscious of grave sin and should have fasted for one hour prior to reception. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior Sacramental Confession except for a grave reason where there is no opportunity for Confession. In this case, the person is to be mindful of the obligation to make an act of perfect contrition, including the intention of confessing as soon as possible. (Code of Canon Law, canon 916). Frequent reception of the Sacrament of Confession is encouraged for all of the faithful.

**For Other Christians** - We welcome to the celebration of Holy Mass those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad division in Christianity that we cannot admit them to a reception of Holy Communion. Catholics believe that the Holy Eucharist signifies a oneness in faith, life and worship. Reception of the Holy Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. (Members of the Eastern Orthodox Churches should follow the discipline of their own canon law regarding coming to Communion).

**For Those Not Receiving Communion** - Those not receiving Sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus.

**For Non-Christians** - We also welcome to Holy Mass those who do not share our faith in Jesus. While we cannot invite them to receive Holy Communion, we do invite them to be united with us in prayer.

# Del Pastor

Queridos Feligreses,

## Pautas de la Sagrada Comunión

**Para los católicos** - Como católicos, participamos plenamente en la celebración de la Santa Misa cuando recibimos la Sagrada Comunión. Se nos anima a recibir a nuestro Señor Eucarístico devotamente y con frecuencia. Para estar debidamente dispuesto a recibirlo, el comulgante no debe ser consciente de un pecado grave y debe haber ayunado durante una hora antes de la recepción. Una persona que es consciente de un pecado grave no es para recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor sin una Confesión Sacramental previa, excepto por una razón grave donde no hay oportunidad para la Confesión. En este caso, la persona debe ser consciente de la obligación de realizar un acto de contrición perfecta, incluida la intención de confesarse lo antes posible. (Código de Derecho Canónico, canon 916). La recepción frecuente del Sacramento de la Confesión es alentada por todos los fieles.

**Para otros cristianos** - Damos la bienvenida a la celebración de la Santa Misa a aquellos cristianos que no están totalmente unidos con nosotros. Es una consecuencia de la triste división en el cristianismo que no podemos admitirlos a una recepción de la Sagrada Comunión. Los católicos creen que la Sagrada Eucaristía significa una unidad en la fe, la vida y la adoración. La recepción de la Sagrada Eucaristía por parte de cristianos no totalmente unidos a nosotros implicaría una unidad que aún no existe, y por la cual todos debemos orar. (Los miembros de las Iglesias Ortodoxas Orientales deben seguir la disciplina de su propia derecho canónico con respecto a la comunión).

**Para aquellos que no reciben la comunión** - Aquellos que no reciben la Comunión Sacramental son alentados a expresar en sus corazones un deseo de oración por la unidad con el Señor Jesús.

**Para no cristianos** - También damos la bienvenida a la Santa Misa a aquellos que no comparten nuestra fe en Jesús. Si bien no podemos invitarlos a recibir la Sagrada Comunión, los invitamos a unirse a nosotros en oración.
