From the Pastor

My Dear Parishioners,

What does the Catholic Church teach about praying for the dead and

Purgatory? Particularly during the month of November we pray for the dead so that their souls through God's mercy will rest in peace. In a special way we can also apply our spiritual works of mercy to help the souls in Purgatory. The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines Purgatory as the "...final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned. (1031)" The elect are all those "who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. (1030).

Sacred Scripture reminds us that this purification is necessary so that nothing unclean would enter into Heaven (Rev. 21:27). So even if we die with all our mortal sins forgiven (which is the best way!), we may have to undergo further purification for any remaining impurities, even for any venial sins. Purgatory is also a purification from the just temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven. Thus, while we are on this earth, we can do something positive for the souls in Purgatory. After we die, it's too late! Therefore, please continue to pray for the souls in Purgatory! Wouldn't you want someone to pray for you? *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord; and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.*

Queridos Feligreses,

¿Qué enseña la Iglesia Católica sobre la oración por los difuntos y el purgatorio? Particularmente durante el mes de noviembre, oramos por los difuntos para que sus almas a través de la misericordia de Dios descansen en paz. De una manera especial, también podemos aplicar nuestras obras espirituales de misericordia para ayudar a las almas en el Purgatorio. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica define al Purgatorio como la "... purificación final de los elegidos, que es completamente diferente del castigo de los condenados. (1031)" Los elegidos son todos aquellos "que mueren en la gracia y amistad de Dios, pero aún imperfectamente. De hecho, los purificados están seguros de su salvación eterna, pero después de la muerte se someten a purificación para alcanzar la santidad necesaria para entrar en el gozo del cielo (1030).

La Sagrada Escritura nos recuerda que esta purificación es necesaria para que nada impuro entre al Cielo (Ap. 21:27). Entonces, incluso si morimos con todos nuestros pecados mortales perdonados (¡que es la mejor manera!), Es posible que tengamos que someternos a una purificación adicional de cualquier impureza restante, incluso de cualquier pecado venial. El purgatorio es también una purificación del justo castigo temporal debido a los pecados ya perdonados. Por lo tanto, mientras estamos en esta tierra, podemos hacer algo positivo por las almas en el Purgatorio. Después de que morimos, es demasiado tarde! Por lo tanto, ¡continúen orando por las almas en el purgatorio! ¿No querrías que alguien orara por ti? *Concédeles el descanso eterno, oh Señor; y que brille la luz perpetua sobre ellos. Que descansen en paz. Amén.*
